Educational Background

Prof. Korn qualified in medicine and obtained a Doctor of Medicine from Mainz University Hospital in 2006. In 2013, she received her 'Habilitation' (PhD) on the topic of 'Cellular and clinical phenotyping of severe asthma for diagnosing and targeted therapy'. In addition, she studied management economy at the Business Academy of the University of St Gallen, Switzerland, graduating in 2009.

Prof. Korn worked together with Prof. Buhl at Mainz University Hospital from 2006 to 2020 and was the head of the Severe Asthma Outpatient Clinic as well as the Head of the Clinical Trial Unit at Mainz University Hospital. In 2020 she founded a private clinical research center and also moved to Thoraxclinic Heidelberg. There she is working together with Prof. Herth and is the head of the Severe Asthma Outpatient Clinic. Prof. Korn's main clinical interests include asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).
